

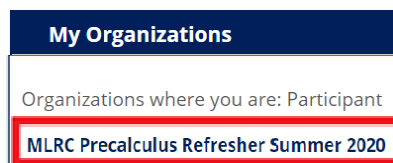
Login Instructions – Precalculus Refresher Blackboard Organization

The MyNova portal allows users to have access to many of Villanova's applications such as email, Banner, Blackboard, Novasis, and more without having to separately log in to those applications.

1. Login to <http://mynova.villanova.edu> using your Villanova username and password.
2. Click on **Blackboard Learn** to link to Villanova's Blackboard system. It should appear under tasks, but if not, you can type it into the search box.



2. At the next "Single Sign On" page click the "LOGIN" button to pass through to the Blackboard system.
3. Go to the My Organizations module on the far right of the screen and click **MLRC Precalculus Refresher Summer 2020** from the organization list.

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: Should I do some reviewing before taking the diagnostic test, or should I to take the test first?

A: The program is designed for you to take the test first. The test report will tell you which areas you need to review. That way, you can spend your time most efficiently by only focusing on the areas for which the test indicates you should study.

Q: Is there a date this program needs to be completed by?

A: You should complete this program before the start of classes. If you are a freshman, I would strongly suggest having it completed before the start of orientation. You will probably not have time to complete it otherwise.

Q: What happens if I do not receive a 28 on the diagnostic test?

A: If you do not receive a 28 on the first try, you should use the resources provided to review the topics suggested in the test report until you feel prepared to retake the test. If you still do not receive a 28, you can study some more and retake the test again. If you feel you need more help than the online resources can provide, you are encouraged to talk to your math professor and visit the Math Learning and Resource Center. Peer tutors will be available throughout the semester to help you review precalculus topics as well as help you with any of your math questions.

Q: Is this a placement test?

A: No, your score on the placement test does not affect which course you are placed into.

Q: I have followed the instructions to find the precalculus refresher program, but I do not see the organization in the "My Organizations" box. How come?

A: If you were recently placed into MAT 1500 or MAT 1505, you may not be enrolled in this program in Blackboard. To be enrolled into the Blackboard organization, send an email request to mlrc@villanova.edu.

Q: Based on my AP test score I will be placing out of MAT 1500 and MAT 1505. Therefore, am I required to complete this program?

A: If you will not be taking MAT 1500 or MAT 1505, you are not required to complete this program. You should check with your academic advisor or the department of your major to verify that you have qualified to place out of both courses. All students are placed into

MAT 1500 until AP scores are received and processed. Your class schedule will eventually be adjusted, but you will continue have access to this program.

Q: If I am not required to do this program because I placed out of both MAT 1500 and MAT 1505 with AP credit or do not plan to take either course, may I still do so?

A: Yes!
